It's hard to believe that over a year has passed since we expanded our mission to look beyond high school graduation for our residents to promote "positive transitions into their adult lives." The Joe's Place Board has put a great deal of care and effort into this change, which involved a comprehensive needs assessment conducted by the Brown School of Social Work at Washington University, as well as learning about trauma-informed practices and the effects of childhood trauma on our residents.

We are beyond excited about the next step in this journey, and that is hiring a caseworker to work directly with the boys to help develop and pursue their individual post-graduation goals. We expect to have this position filled by the end of the calendar year and we can't wait to see how this reshapes our program and the impact it makes on the lives of these young men.

On a different note, my term as the Board President will draw to a close in January, and I would like to take this opportunity to say thank you to my fellow board members, past and present. I have been continuously impressed with the level of dedication, professionalism and wisdom displayed by our board, and it has been a true honor to serve with you all. I would also like to express my deep appreciation for the MRH staff members who work tirelessly and selflessly in

support of Joe's Place, particularly Vince Estrada, Kat Norton, Amber Silver, and Ed Rich. I also owe a debt of gratitude and a portion of my personal sanity - to
